授業の目的	The aim of this course is for students to expand their view of the world through English-language news media sources, such as newspapers, magazines, news broadcasts, and online news sites. Students will improve their reading, listening, speaking, and writing skills as they understand, evaluate, and reflect on a variety of perspectives in the news. This course builds on the skills and knowledge gained in Media English 1 (メディア英語1).								
到達目標	Students will: 1. Learn about different types of news stories. 2. Use strategies to understand the main idea of news stories. 3. Critically evaluate and reflect on news stories. 4. Improve reading, listening, speaking, and writing skills. 5. Increase vocabulary and grammar knowledge.								
授業外学修内容・ 授業外学修時間数	Students are expected to read and listen to the news in English and Japanese on a daily basis, write and record audio short reports about news stories, review lesson material for quizzes, and study related vocabulary. Students must spend more than 15 hours outside of class in preparation for this course.
